WHO CAN YOU WORK WITH?

The potential of this career is limitless! Wherever there are people, opportunities in business abound. Your clientele will be individuals or groups you feel strongly about—whether you prefer working with groups or individuals. Perhaps you have personal experience with addiction and want to specialize in that area, or you've overcome low self-esteem and wish to help others build theirs. Whether your focus is on children or corporate clients, we'll guide you in targeting your market effectively to achieve success and make a meaningful impact on those you care about.

However, it's important to note that if your clients require therapeutic intervention or are susceptible to triggers, you should be a licensed clinician.

For instance, if you're leading an equine therapy program without qualifications as a therapist or psychologist, it's unethical to provide treatment to clients in that capacity. Using the term "therapy" requires the presence of a licensed clinical professional.

EQUINE ASSISTED LEARNING VS. EQUINE THERAPY

Equine assisted learning is an experiential method of developing life skills. Facilitated by a qualified professional to meet educational, professional, and personal needs (goals) through intentionally designed interactions with horses within a group format or one-on-one and focuses on ground activities rather than riding horses.

The horse provides therapeutic benefits and healing to all in their presence. A connection to the unconscious. Therapeutic programs and exercises to solidify the skills that humans learn with horses about themselves.

Equine Therapy is when licensed or certified medical or behavioural health professionals, operating within their counselling, occupational therapy, physical therapy, psychotherapy, recreational therapy, or speech-language pathology scope of practice, provide therapy. These professionals assess how interactions with horses, equine movement, or elements of the equine environment can enhance a client's personalized treatment plan. The goal is to improve the client's sensorimotor, cognitive, behavioural, emotional, or psychological functioning to promote better health and well-being.

It is considered best practice for therapy professionals to receive specialized training specifically geared towards safely integrating horses into treatment.

WHAT DO THE DIFFERENT ACRONYMS MEAN?

Equine Assisted Activities (EAA): an umbrella term for all activities and interventions, both therapeutic and non-therapeutic, including equines. Both mounted and non-mounted activities.

Equine Assisted Interventions (EAI): a term used to describe a range of different activities and treatments including equines, aiming to reshape mental/physical processes

Equine Assisted Learning (EAL): experiential learning approach including equines in the process of learning, aiming to improve different life skills such as communication skills, relationship skills, leadership skills, self-awareness, personal growth (not therapy). EAL includes various different approaches, mounted and non-mounted.

Equine Assisted Mindfulness (EAM): mindfulness/ present-moment awareness practices including equines.

Equine Assisted Psychotherapy (EAP): a form of experiential therapy done together with equines, a licensed mental health professional, and often also including an equine professional in the team. Different psychological approaches may be used in EAP depending on the mental health professional.

Equine Assisted Trauma Therapy (EATT): experiential mental health service, focused specifically on trauma treatment, including equines in the treatment team together with a licensed mental health professional and often an equine professional.

Equine Assisted Personal Development (EAPD): EAPD is an experiential, therapeutic approach that involves being in the presence of, and working alongside the horse to help uncover truths about yourself.

Equine-Facilitated Learning (EFL): EFL covers a wide array of social and emotional learning activities organized around horse experiences. EFL facilitators may be experienced educators, business consultants, personal coaches or certified in alternative health fields. Practitioners of EFL are not regulated or licensed; consumers should ask about the EFL practitioner's background and qualifications. EFL may contribute to positive outcomes for a client although the activity itself is not therapy.

Equine-Facilitated Psychotherapy (EFP): EFP is a type of experiential psychotherapy built around interactions with horses. Therapy must be applied by a provider who is trained and licensed (by their state) to practice psychotherapy or counselling. The therapist should have additional training and experience in facilitating EFP; often sessions are facilitated jointly by a trained therapist and an equine specialist especially when working with more than one client at a time. Also known as: Equine Assisted Psychotherapy, Equine-Facilitated Mental Health, Equine Assisted Counselling.



Please remember: It is unethical to assert that you are conducting a therapy program unless you are a licensed clinician. While horses are inherently therapeutic, it is inappropriate to engage in therapeutic practices or make such claims without proper education and training.

HOW ARE HORSES TAKEN CARE OF WHILE RUNNING YOUR BUSINESS

How is the welfare of the horse considered in the certifications you are looking at? Is it considered at all? How do you know?

The horse is primary in all we do, so it is essential that we are not USING horses, but rather WORKING WITH HORSES. Here are a few questions to consider in how horses are being worked with.

01

WHAT ARE THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE HORSES?

How many programs would you be running a week? What will keep your horses safe and maintained?

We suggest you do not over work your horses and run a maximum of one program per day with your horses. If it is suggested you do more than that, it could severely damage your horses and take away from their full welfare.

02

ARE THEY TEACHERS OR TOOLS?

If you are not taking the initiative to understand your horses better and truly understand their language and culture, then you are using your horses as tools.

To truly partner with our horses we must understand them to the highest level that we can and always be willing to continue to learn more!

03

WHY DOES THE FULL WELFARE OF THE HORSE MATTER?

We have all been told to take care of feet, or basic teeth care, but the full welfare of the horse means more than that. It is understanding and ensuring the five freedoms of the horse:

- Freedom from Hunger and Thirst - by ready access to fresh water and a diet to maintain full health and vigour.
- Freedom from Discomfort - by providing an appropriate environment including shelter and a comfortable resting area.
- Freedom from Pain, Injury and Disease - by prevention or rapid diagnosis and treatment.
- Freedom to Express Normal Behaviour - by providing sufficient space, proper facilities and company of the animal's own kind.
- Freedom from Fear and Distress - by ensuring conditions and treatment which avoid mental suffering.

PROFIT? NON-PROFIT? CHARITY?

What's the difference?

A for-profit organization is one that operates with the goal of making money. Most businesses are for-profits that serve their customers by selling a product or service. The business owner earns an income from the profit and may also pay shareholders and investors from the profits.

A not-for-profit organization is an association or corporation committed to operating "exclusively for social welfare, civic improvement, pleasure, recreation, or any other purpose except profit". This means that the not-for-profit organization helps a specific social cause without a pecuniary gain or "net profit".

Registered charities are charitable organizations, public foundations, or private foundations that use their resources for charitable activities and have charitable purposes.

CAN I ADD THIS TO MY EXISTING BUSINESS?

Absolutely! Many facilitators have successfully integrated EAL into riding programs, sensory farms, therapy and counselling services, life coaching, and even yoga retreats. The possibilities are endless for expanding your existing business or collaborating with others!

WILL MY FACILITY WORK? WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE ONE YET?

Whether you have an arena or not, stalls or open space, prefer an indoor or outdoor classroom, whether it's your own facility or someone else's — it can all work! You don't necessarily need a large area; just a fenced space for the programs and another area for briefings and debriefings will suffice. Many clients appreciate a rustic setting where they can connect with nature and learn.

Collaborating with other facilities is also an option. We successfully did this for the first two years of our program! Many facilitators start out not knowing where they will run their business, but end up finding their location once they discover what they need during the course.

WHAT HORSES?

● HOW MANY HORSES CAN YOU WORK WITH?

Golden rule is one facilitator can handle two horses with up to four participants per horse.

● WHAT AGE SHOULD MY HORSES BE?

A horse isn't mentally developed until at least five years old. And you want to make sure your horse has life skills and is safe!

● HOW MANY HORSES DO I NEED?

You don't need a large herd to start running programs. You would need up to two horses per facilitator and you wouldn't run them in back-to-back courses

● WHAT KIND OF HORSE SHOULD I WORK WITH?

Big or small, quarter horse or gypsy, it doesn't matter as long as they are safe horses. It isn't based off of looks! But you would NOT work with green broke horses or stallions!



CAN I AFFORD THIS? IS THERE A PAYMENT PLAN?

Not everyone has spare cash lying around, but where there is a will there is a way! There are many funding opportunities such as grants, or small business loans that can help you get going. PLUS there is a payment plan for your certification that allows you to break up the payments to make it a little easier on the pocketbook.

This is a career with horses, not just a course. We invest back into you for the life of your career. We continually provide training you for the life of your certification and included how to build a sustainable business, find your success with help, and support 24/7. It's the investment that keeps on going with your one time investment.

CAN I EXPECT A RETURN ON INVESTMENT?

Are you going to be a millionaire? No. Will you make enough to make a decent living? Yes. Creating a nice balance for you (and your horses) to get to your ROI depends on how fast you move forward. Some people start right away and make their return on investment right away, other take it slow. It is completely up to you!

Starting a business makes financial sense! You are already spending the money on your horses, but now that is a good thing! Your bookkeeper will balance your books showing your expenses (ex: certified course, hay, supplements, vet, farrier, cell phone, a portion of house etc.) vs. income - deducting from the amount of tax you would have to pay!

Even with a RISK to begin your own business, what do you have to lose? You already spend money to live this life every day. Why not turn expenses into 'Write-Off's'?

START-UP COSTS

The start-up costs to run your course can be fairly minimal! You would need a place to hold your programs and your horses, of course, but here is an example list of the rest of the items you would need;

- Name tags for participants
- Props/flowers/noodles/large ball
- Bathroom – indoor or outdoor
- Clothes pins from dollar store. Multi colours and a bag of just blue. Smaller size.
- 5 blind folds from dollar store
- 40--50 coloured rails 10' or 12' - MINIMUM OF 3 ROUND RAILS
- Dowels (10) with a slit on top for placing a card of instruction
- Groom Kits
- Word boards
- Old or mismatched gloves
- 8--10 little blocks to raise the rails off the ground
- Pool Noodles
- Bandage horse wraps
- 15--20 pylons with hole on top
- Balls
- Solid steps/box
- Arena fold-able table
- Hula hoops from dollar store
- 3-4 baskets to hold clips
- Clipboards with pencils
- 4-5 short lead ropes 5-6'
- Horse demo head
- Extra halter and lead ropes
- Barrel
